# Blast Cleaning adds new dimension to service

Rainbow International has recently added a new dimension to its Restoration and Cleaning service, with the introduction of a blast cleaning process.

Several franchisees have previously invested in blast cleaning equipment to undertake graffiti removal for commercial work, but many are now investing in the system and training that can utilise the same equipment and technology for smoke and soot removal in domestic situations.

Rainbow's branch in Thames Estuary North, used the system previously to remove some graffiti on a wall for the London Borough of Hackney. Rainbow's local Project Manager and his team have long used the blasting equipment to remove graffiti and clean areas that are difficult to deal with, and the systems versatility now means they can utilise it for domestic claims following a fire.

In addition to the blast cleaning equipment, recognised training, PPE, and compressors which supply the power, have all been part of the investment that Rainbow has made to introduce this additional service.

Rainbow Thames Estuary North was the natural choice for Hackney Council for graffiti removal. They have previously worked on many fire related incidents as well as for high access and bio-hazard work where he has been used, among many other unusual cleaning requirements, to remove bird fouling from lofts and high building ledges.
